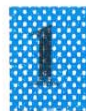

CUSTOMS SYSTEM LAUNCHING OF INFORMATION AND DATA BASING MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE

The implementation of these systems will be held in Algiers port from September 8th 2004 and will be spread all over computerized customs (offices) that cover nearly 96% of external trade operations.

The system of computerized management of risks leads to 3 circuits called as follows :



THE GREEN CIRCUIT

giving the right to immediate removal goods source (fees and taxes) right after the payment (or the deposit) of fees taxes dues without physical visit of these goods.



THE ORANGE CIRCUIT

giving the right of goods removal after special administrative control formalities only that of payment (the deposit) of fees and taxes dues.



THE RED CIRCUIT

Submitting goods removal to a partial or integral checking up and to the payment or (deposit) of fees and taxes dues.
